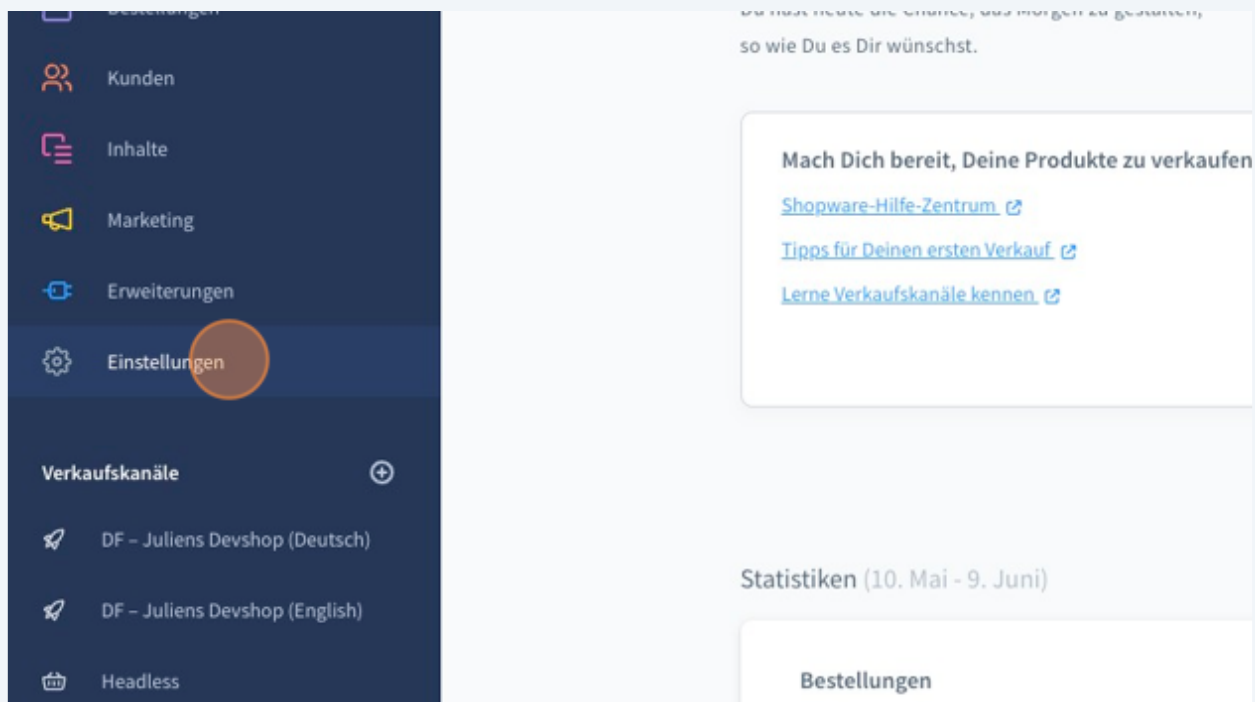


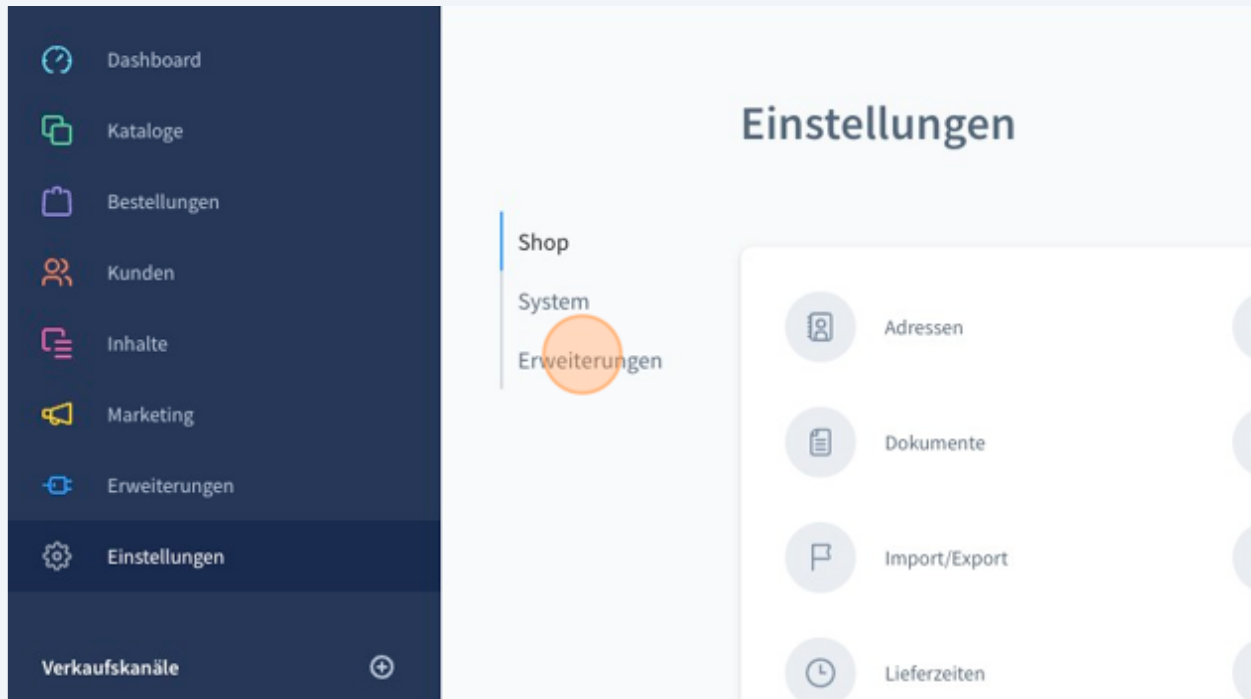
Creation of a new DooFinder store for a Shopware storefront sales channel

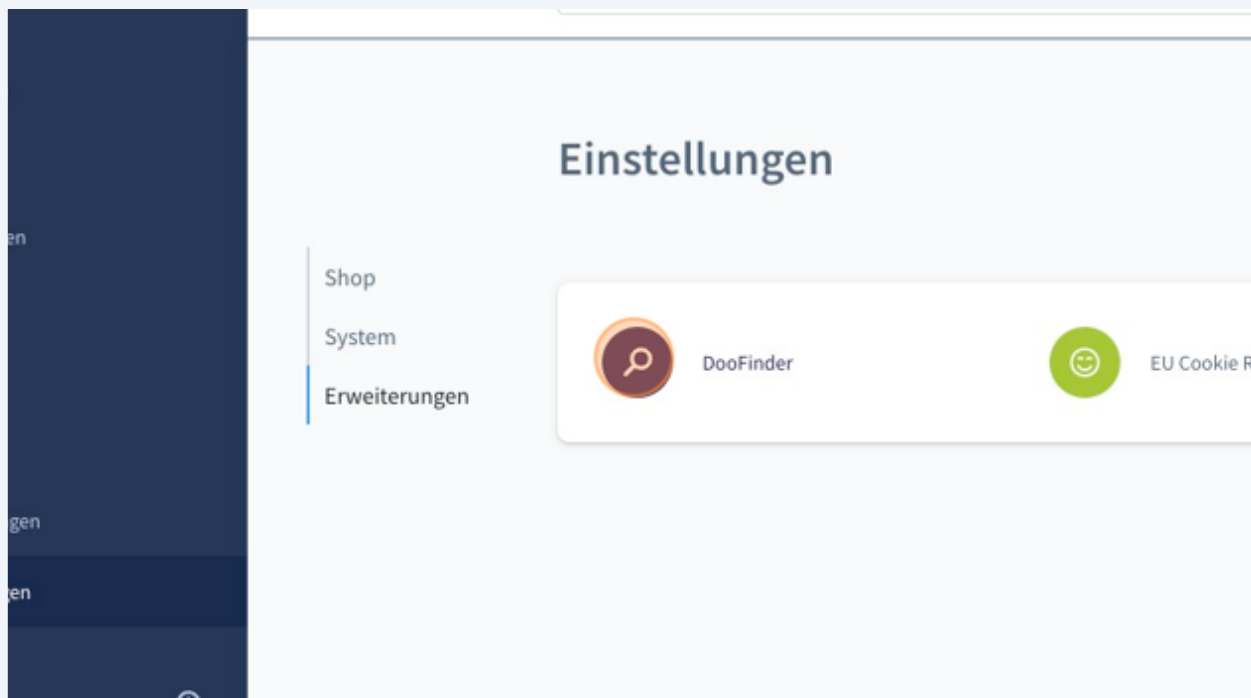
A storefront sales channel in Shopware is represented by a "Store" in DooFinder. There is always at least one store in the DooFinder account. If required, additional stores can be created via the Shopware administration. The administration can be found under "Settings".



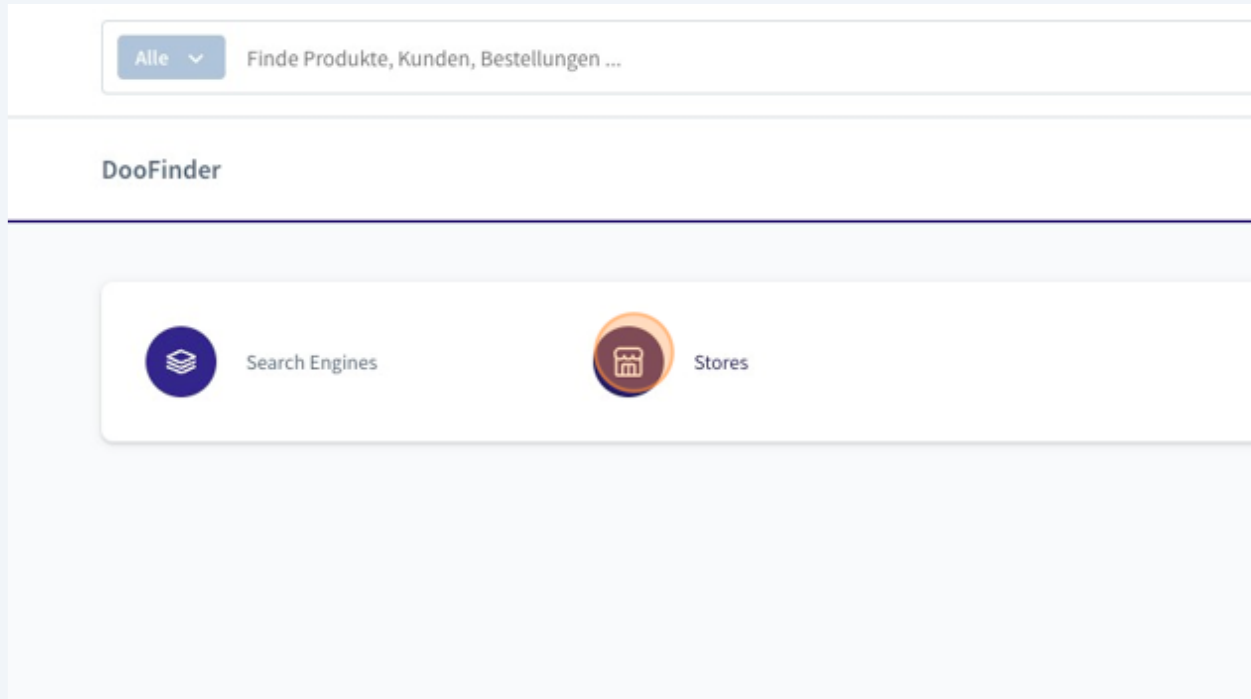
2 At "Extensions".



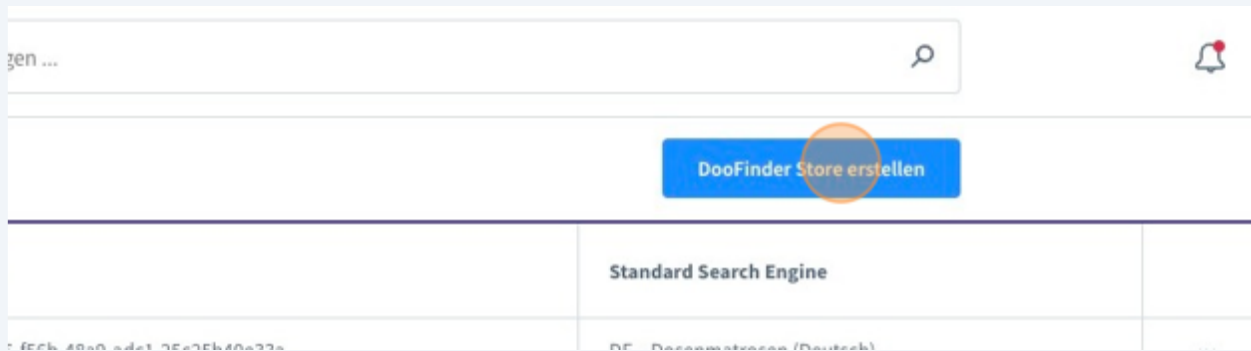
3 In the "DooFinder" section.

Both a name and a CSS selector for the search field in the shop must be specified. The CSS selector depends on the shop's individual template. In most cases the selector `input[name="search"]` works.
